Rules

The founding concept of the Finest Kind Quickie has always been about getting out early and finding the fish with few rules and lots of fun. As this tournament and its winnings have grown, the need for consistency has become more important. In this regard, we will strive for as few rules as possible while we ensure that we're all on a level playing field.

- **IGFA tournament approved circle hooks ONLY**
- Six rods per boat
- No spinning reels
- 20 lb. Momoi's Diamond Hi-Vis Line
- You may pass rods off
- You may put baits back in during a catch
- No live bait
- No pitching or casting into bait schools
- Double lines are measured from the start of the knot, braid, or splice making the double, to the furthestmost end of the knot, splice, snap, swivel, or other device used for securing the trace, leader, lure, or hook to the double line. **The double line shall be limited to 15 feet. The combined length of the double line and leader shall not exceed 20 feet; this includes the hook.**
- The use of leader is not required. If one is used it must meet the following specifications: the length of the leader is the overall length including a lure, hook arrangement, or other device. There are no regulations regarding the material or strength of the leader. **The leader shall be limited to 15 feet. The combined length of the double line and leader shall not exceed 20 feet, this includes the hook.**
- Tournament fishing area: northern boundary 28°.00'.00 North; southern boundary 26°.46.00 North
- Boats must check in with the committee boat between 6:30am –7:00am.
- All tournament boats must leave and return via the St. Lucie Inlet, no exceptions.
- Boats will be directed by the committee boat to depart the St Lucie Inlet sea buoy area at 7:00am.
- BOATS: Minimum size is 31 ft.
- Lines in at 8:30am; lines out at 3:30pm.
- Boats must be inside the St. Lucie Inlet jetty by 5:00pm.
- Committee boat VHF channel 10.
- **Release is official when swivel or leader knot touches the rod tip, or mate takes control of the leader.**
- Winners will be determined by total number of releases by time.
- Beyond exceptions stated above, IGFA rules apply.

- **ALL BOATS *MUST* PROVIDE AN OBSERVER.**
- First boat to catch a tagged fish must remove tag, by witness of an independently assigned observer, and photograph with time/date stamp, or videotape said removal of tag.
- Participants and observers are subject to polygraph testing.
- Committee boat must be notified of release of TAGGED fish, or your fish will not count as first tagged.
- Boat to release first tagged fish under said conditions automatically qualifies to choose one envelope from 200, one of which will read "YOU WIN." Winning envelope pays out \$1,000,000 in a 40 year annuity, paid in equal monthly installments. (Some restrictions apply; consult tournament director for full details).
- In the event that no tagged fish are released, all eligible boats will be put in a drawing for the opportunity to draw for the \$1,000,000 envelope. (Must be present at drawing for opportunity to win.)
- Protests must be submitted to tournament rule committee in writing by 7pm the day of said infraction, accompanied by a \$100 protest fee.
